



## Citing Web Sites and Web Pages MLA Format

Cite as many of the following items that are available on the website/webpage:

- The name of the author or corporate author.
- The title of the site, underlined.
- The title of the page or short work, in quotation marks.
- The names of any editors.
- The date of publication or last update.
- The name of any sponsoring organization.
- The date you accessed the website.
- The URL in angle brackets.
