Include as much the following information that is available:

1. Author.
2. \*Publication\*, article title (in quotes) and citation information.
3. \*The name of the database\*.
4. The name of the service.
5. The name and location of the library where you retrieved the article.
6. The date on which you retrieved the article.
7. The URL of the service.

**\*Must be underlined or in italics, ask your instructor which they prefer.**
