



TEST OF ESSENTIAL ACADEMIC SKILLS (TEAS)

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) is required of all applicants to the Pulaski Technical College Practical Nursing program. The TEAS consists of Reading, Mathematics, Science and English. Applicants to the Pulaski Technical College Practical Nursing program may apply between September 1 and April 15 of each year for admission into the following fall class.

Important Information about the Test of Essential Academic Skills

- The Test of Essential Academic Skills is offered on Thursdays, and some Saturdays, at various times. Please go to http://rasmus.pulaskitech.edu/public/testing_lab/nursing_assessment.php to view the available dates/times and to register for the TEAS.

- The TEAS is timed and it takes approximately 3 hours 29 minutes (209 minutes) to complete.

- You are able to take the TEAS twice in each application year, and scores are valid for 2 years.
- A valid photo ID is required; no exceptions.
- Cost of the test is \$30. Pay testing fees at the Cashier window located on the 2nd floor of the Campus Center Building.
- The test is administered in Counseling and Advising, 2nd floor of the Campus Center Building, room 240.
- Calculators are not allowed, but scratch paper and pencils are provided.
- Cell phones are not allowed.
- Children are not allowed.
- If you have a documented disability, please contact Disability Support Services for accommodations before you arrive for the test.
